Geoff gave a report on the Club's Photographic Exhibition, "The Year of the Forest" which was held at the Old Court House Belmore Basin, Wollongong on 10th, 11th September. There were 112 Images hung and many thanks go to the sponsors and supports of this exhibition; The Old Court House, Lever's Art and Graphic Supplies, Wollongong Camera House, DNA Framing, Figtree Primary School and the 20 Camera Club volunteers who spent much time Friday putting up the display and manning the Exhibition over the weekend as well as selling tickets for the Guessing Competition. This year there were not good crowds through the exhibition and next year it is hoped with coincide with Art in the Park at Belmore Basin and to have more advance publicity.

President Craig presented the monthly merit, credit and Best in Section award certificates. Craig then introduced the guest speaker Mick Lincoln who is a lecturer at the Senior College Port Kembla. Mike has been teaching photography for 30 years and now has 4 classes running. Since 2000 Mike has been experimenting with printing on various mediums and this was his topic for the evening. Mike had samples of how the same image appears – depending on what medium you use to print it on. Mike likes to use Epson printers and he used archival papers or uses a Crystal Clear Spray of the finished print. This spray is available from Levers and stops UV light fading the image. One can also use a wood clear glue over the image sometimes as this will show texture on final result as brush strokes.
